

Feed Flint Eligibility

Eligibility

- Must be a current Flint Housing Commission (FHC) resident in Low-Income Public Housing with an outstanding rent balance.
- Must have no open lease violations.
- Residents and family members must register and be approved for volunteer service through Resident Services or Family Self-Sufficiency Coordinators.
- Credits apply only to verified rent arrears, not future rent or other charges.

How It Works

1. Sign Up for Volunteer Service
 - Residents (or family members) volunteer at the Food Bank of Eastern Michigan (FBEM).
2. Earn Credits
 - FBEM verifies volunteer hours.
 - For each hour:
 - FBEM provides \$0.91/hour credit to offset FHC's food program costs.
 - FHC applies a \$10.00/hour rent credit (funded by GLAN and managed via HFC COCC) toward the resident's unpaid rent balance.
3. Impact
 - Every hour volunteered reduces rent owed and supports Flint's food programs.

Registration Process

- Complete the registration form which can be found on the FHCs Website.
- Resident Services or Family Self-Sufficiency Coordinators will follow up with confirmation email.

Important Notes

- Family and friends can volunteer on behalf of residents.
- Program applies to rent arrears from Jan 1 – Dec 31, 2025.
- Not intended for future rent payments
